

Every artist has their own unique lens on how they view their world. Dorothy Clare Zarren captures these moments to transform snapshots of the everyday into a dynamic canvas of rich hues wrought with emotion. Influenced by fashion and portrait photography, the pop culture that saturates our ordinary lives, and visuals with intense color palettes and drama, Zarren draws inspiration from photographs of friends, family, and the people around her. Through this process, the images create a visual reference for her paintings and screenprints where each piece has its own story, one filled with mystery which elicits an evocative vitality that leaves the viewer guessing, yet still wanting more.

Dorothy Clare Zarren got her BA at Skidmore College where she completed a double major in Studio Art with concentrations in both oil painting and graphic design, and Psychology. She also studied at Parsons Paris in France, an affiliate of the Parsons School of Design. Zarren completed the Post-Baccalaureate Program at the School of the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston in December 2009. She has a studio at Vernon Street Studios in Somerville, MA and participates annually in both the Vernon Street Open Studios and the Somerville Open Studios.
